



ENJOY A TRADITIONAL ISTRIAN DINNER



Tasting the food and drink enjoyed by generations of Istrian villagers will surely be one of your most memorable and delicious highlights during this tour. We will visit a traditional Konoba "Gastro Tavern" in a timeless quintessential Istrian town. The traditional meal will include the absolute best regional cuisine – homemade using the finest seasonal and local artisanal ingredients. With a long history to Northern Italy, Istria is home to incredible culinary dishes and drinks which rival Italian food and wine from the land and the sea. Once such culinary dish is the region's local pasta, "Fuzi." This penne-like pasta is usually served with a slathering of fresh shaved truffles or a sauce with a highly prized regional meat - boskarina (which of course, you will experience)! We will complete the evening with pastries or traditional crepes called Palecinke!

HISTORIC & CULTURAL TOURS OF MOTOVUN, PULA, ROVINJ, ZAGREB



There is so much to cover in each of these great towns and cities. I will leave this to our expert local tour guides and to our own discoveries. Count on walking around the cobblestone streets of four of the most fascinating, vibrant, and beautiful cities of Istria and in Croatia's capital city - Zagreb. These are all ancient cities with plenty of culture to unpack. Each carries their own unique characteristics and charms. I cannot wait to show you my favourite places – including off-the-beaten paths of the tourist shops. The days will go quickly but through it all, we will enjoy breaks at cafes/artisanal tasting and have personal time to enjoy the Istrian way of life -living in the moment!

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TASTINGS - OLIVE OIL - WINE - LOCAL SPIRTS



A culinary tour of Istria begins the moment you arrive on this heart-shaped peninsula. We will taste local cuisine and enjoy exquisite wine and traditional spirits tastings at some of the most respected and award-winning wineries, brandy, olive oil and food producers. All great sources of sustenance will be explored but a highlight will be the olive oil production will an educational tour and tasting at a top producer, known as the "bible of olive oil". A wine tour is another significant and important experience for all. The art of winemaking spans generations with production using old technics and care using modern technology. You will see a balance of history in production with modern methods – your taste buds will not regret it. Trust me, after each tasting experience, you will want to bring brandy, oil, and wine home. Make sure you have extra storage in your luggage.

HELPFUL INSIGHTS

FLIGHT INFO: How long is the flight from Toronto to Zagreb, Croatia? Average direct flight time is 8 hours 35 minutes. There are short 1.5/2hr layovers with most airlines.

Reminder to arrive at the airport early to accommodate for international travel requirements. The international Zagreb airport (ZAG) is modern, easy to maneuver, and English is widely and comfortably used. There are many options for transport from the airport to our destination – from local transit, Uber, taxis to limo services. Once you check in to the hotel, you are welcome to relax and discover Zagreb until our early evening meet-up.

SPRING & AUTUMN WEATHER CONDITIONS

Generally, warm sunny days (high teens -20s) with slight chances of cool and rainy days with cooler evenings (10-14 degrees). Please bring sunblock and clothes to layer. We will provide a weather report a few days prior to our trip.

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PACKING TIPS

Many of you are well-traveled and astute packers for all seasons and regions. However, these are helpful tips for first timers to Europe and more specifically, Croatia.

- 1. Comfortable shoes - walking shoes for daytime tours and strolls around cobblestone streets, pair of dressy shoes for evening outings, waterproof sandals (for pools/beaches) and athletic shoes for Exercise.
- 2. Clothing - Croatia and Europe in general, lean to the dresser-casual side of fashion. Apart from your usual essentials, I would suggest a few wrinkle-free casual outfits for daytime tastings and 1-2 dresser-casual items for evening dinners. Always pack something for cooler temperatures - sometimes the weather is cool-breezy due to the bordering north-west alps. Helpful to have a sun hat for protection. If you are planning to swim, do yoga, run, cycle, or any other athletics, bring your bathing suit and workout clothes. Umbrella/Rain Jacket (in case it rains).
- 3. Adaptable Charger - Croatia like much of Europe uses different plugs and sockets than in Canada – they use Plug & Outlet C and F type – Make sure to bring an adapter for your electronics with C&F adaption.
- WIFI is strong and available most everywhere in public spaces for free. There are many options to use a service/buy data for your own iPhone. Your CDN/US phone will require the capacity for an ESIM which you can get from your phone provider. For example, it will cost \$10-\$15 from Rogers. This must be done in person at the Canadian phone provider store. Many travelers to Europe use AIRALO to purchase very affordable data for their phones. - Currency & Tipping The official currency is the EURO Croatia is an EU country. Major credit cards are accepted everywhere. However, it is advisable to have a Euros on hand for quick/marketplace purchases and tipping at restaurants as they don't have a way to include tips by credit. You may want to tip our tour guides following each tour and our dedicated driver at the end of our trip. Please consider setting aside approx. 5 euros per tour guide and 20 euros per driver. There may be places/restaurants where you may want to tip. General rule of thumb - round up your receipt for smaller purchases (for example, if you are billed = \$13.50 - you can round up to \$15.00. For great service around 10% of the bill. It is advised to have euros in your pocket for cases like this.
- Toiletries and Medicine Croatia has a great health care system and pharmacies but bringing your own -especially medicine will prevent having to book time away from all the fun things you will be doing.
- 7. Extra foldable bag - I always recommend an extra bag to have in case of irresistible local purchases like truffle products, wines, olive oils, art etc. Trust me on this one!
- Day bag/purse which I highly recommend with a strap to wear cross body to keep your important valuables nearby.
- Reusable water bottle Croatia has some of the cleanest tap water in the world. Many Croatians practice sustainable living and encourage the use of reusing water bottles or buying plastic.
